PRIVACY ACT

Introduction

The *Privacy Act* provides citizens with the right to access personal information held by the government and protection of that information against unauthorized use and disclosure

Section 72 of the *Privacy Act* requires the heads of federal government institutions to submit a report to Parliament on their institutions' administration of the Act each fiscal year. This report is tabled in Parliament in accordance with section 72 of the Act.

The Port of Thunder Bay became a Canadian Port Authority under the provisions of the *Canada Marine Act* on July 1, 1999.

Thunder Bay Port Authority (TBPA) holds the responsibility for management, maintenance and control of the Port of Thunder Bay.

TBPA did not process any requests during this time under the Privacy Act.

Structure

As established practice, all formal requests for access to information are sent to the Access to Information Coordinator and treated pursuant to the provisions of the Act.
